Yournew traveled the 1000 miles to Nairobi this week to bring Church Reports from ten different Evangelists. Yournew is sick with the flu but regaining his strength. He will return to the Malek Church compound after one week in Nairobi. He says "The **good** news is reports from our 18 students who graduated in 2007; but the **great** news is that our new Evangelists have established 7 churches in their own villages."

ELECTRIC GENERATOR

We found a new, 60 kw Gen/Set in Nairobi for \$18,000.00. Thanks to many who have sacrificed and a steady flow of funds have come in. We are still \$4,000.00 short but I have confidence in you that the rest will come to SAM. We will go ahead and Yournew will return to Malek Hospital with the new generator on board. There will be much ditch digging by hand to get the underground wiring to the Hospital, Church Building and Bible College. Then fuse panels so the power is on. When we had a little 4 kw the compound looked like an Oasis in the desert but gave up being overworked with night Bible studies.

THREE WATER WELLS

The water well drilling company already has their big drilling equipment in Aweil Town, about 35 miles from Malek; they are ready to start drilling three water wells. They have been charging \$12 to \$13 thousand US dollars for each well; but they agreed to drill three wells for \$27,000.00. SAM has money for two wells and accumulating more for the 3rd.
