Ox plow for Food for Life is requested. We are praying that there will be funds for ox plows so that we can buy a few oxen and hoes so we can plant food during the rainy season. Four teams will be a good start. Each bulls costs 350 USD and eight bulls will cost around 2800 USD. We are praying that this year will be a blessed season for all the farmers. The time is short for South Sudan to receive rain. There will be a need to buy seeds to get to farmers.

Although there were some security problems during the conflicts in South Sudan between Sudan People Liberation Army and Dr. Riak Machar in some areas, we are grateful now that the situation in the South is peaceful and things are back to normal. We are kindly asking SSAM to pray for South Sudan government and the people to have final peace and the love of God to come to their hearts and bring peace to the country.

March 2014 Reports: In this month we have admitted 51 patients with no deaths recorded throughout the month. All were discharged cured! We are thanking God for the mercy and blessing He has for the work of our hands. The patient record books has 674 patients in the month of March as a treated number of patients with medical follow up. Now we are still programming to visit IDPs (Internally Displaced People) at their houses and teach them Primary Health Care.

April 2014 Reports: There have already been 375 patients, 34 admissions and two exhausted patients were brought who died instantly.

Drug Store and Medicine Supply: The store is well stocked and equipped with essential drugs and medicine. The only problem is the population we have in Malek and sometimes people come from the other sites of Aweil state and therefore we run short of medicine. Some of the far villages need to be reached by the Mobile Clinic if the mission is successfully purchasing the vehicle for the church to use it for outreach.

Yournew and Dr. John had concerns that the vehicle would be carjacked or looted while in transit to Aweil.
