In our church we are blessed to have a wonderful congregation and we are praying that it will grow every day.

We baptized 6 people and 12 more members were converted into the church in Uyoon alone. Twenty four more people are waiting to be baptized next Sunday. Our people are changing gradually to Christianity from believing in their African Gods. We are thanking God for showing our community a way to His Kingdom. Every Sunday we pray for peace among our people, tribes and between communities around us and peace in the world.

Luka is requesting funds for eye surgery. Luka does not have a US sponsor and for \$300 a month an individual, a congregation or a Sunday School Group could sponsor this diligent young evangelist. If you would like to sponsor Luka or help with the cost of his \$3,750 eye surgery, please send your funds to SSAM and designate "Luka".

The problem with my (left) eye began when I was a young boy. It has white color (spot) in the eye. This condition can lead to vision loss which will prone me to reading inability. I am requesting to SSAM for my eye treatment. The treatment for my eye can be done in Kampala, Uganda or Nairobi, Kenya with surgical procedure. I didn't know the cause of this eye condition since it began at my childhood.

The followings were identified as the course of costs:

- 1. Transport from Aweil to Kampala will costs me \$700
- 2. Treatment (eye surgery) can cost up to \$1500
- 3. Accommodation and feeding costs is estimated at \$1000
- 4. And domestic transport while on treatment costs \$200
- 5. Possibility of added costs for eye glasses that might be prescribed are estimated at \$350.

Total course will be \$3750. I have no other sources of income except SSAM. I kindly request SSAM to sponsor the course of my eye treatment so that I can continue reading the gospel of Christ in our churches to our people here in Aweil.

If I am not treating this eye disease now then in the next intake of ABC I will not be able to see to stand and see to teach because of eye problem. In going to Kampala or Nairobi my wife needs to be with me because at time of surgery there is a need for next of kin to sign the agreeable papers. I may not be able to use my eye for seeing immediately after surgery too. I am requesting you that we pray together for the success of my eye problem.

Dr. John examined my eye condition and proved the diagnosis of my eye condition to be Cataract and he concluded that there are no Cataract Surgical Wet Lab (or specialized health centers that are well equipped with cataract surgical tools and personnel) in our states and Juba hospital will need booking for surgeons (specialized ophthalmologists) that are residing outside the country.
